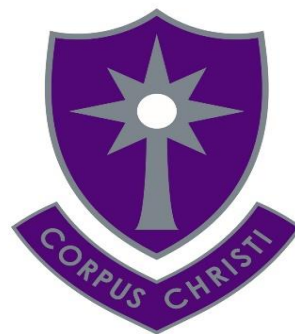

Dear Parent / Carers

I want to thank you all for your continued support. We are looking forward to welcoming you all back. All students will return at 8.45 am on **Thursday 11 March and go direct to their tutor/form group room**. This will allow us to implement a structured re-integration programme for all learners over the first seven days.

Until Thursday 11 March, the College will remain open to key worker and resource base students only. Online learning provision will continue for all students until Thursday 11 March and work will continue to be set. However, staff will not necessarily be responding immediately to any queries regarding online learning on the Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday in order to fully prepare for the College reopening on Thursday 11 March.

Students must be in the classroom for their first lesson ready to learn at 8.45am. This means that students need to be through the main gate at no later than 8.40am. Any student not in the classroom at 8.45am prompt will receive a late mark and normal attendance protocols will be in place from 11<sup>th</sup> March.
