COURSE DESCRIPTION

Students will sit 4 exams at the end of Year 11:

- 1 x Speakina Exam
- 1 x Writing Exam
- 1 x Reading Exam
- 1 x Listening Exam

ENRICHMENT

Cultural knowledge and experience e.g. tapas tasting, Spanish films, flamenco dancing, customs and festivals. Regular intervention and catch up sessions for any students who need them.

PROGRESSION ROUTE/S

Students achieving a Grade 6 or above can progress to A Level Spanish. Several BTEC /NVQ courses also involve a language component. Working knowledge of a second language is useful in a wide variety of different work contexts.
